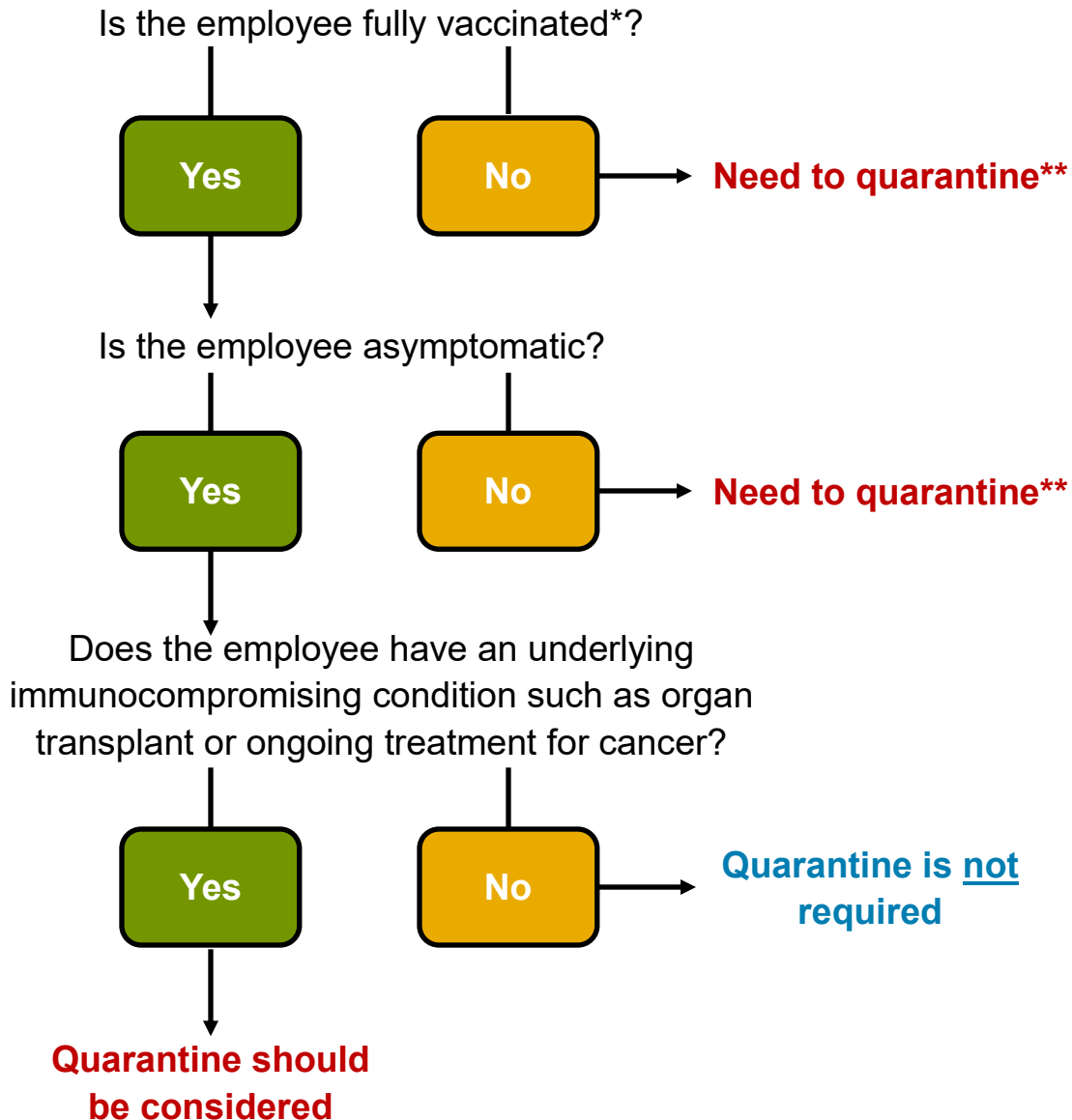


# Work Restrictions Due to COVID-19 Exposure

This guide is to assist in determining when employees should be excluded from work due to COVID-19 exposure as recommended by the CDC.



\* Fully vaccinated is defined as an individual that has received both doses of a two-dose vaccine greater than 2 weeks ago or one dose of a single-dose vaccine greater than 2 weeks ago.

\*\* Quarantine is defined as a period of 14 days from the date of known high risk exposure. During the 14 days, individuals should monitor themselves for signs/symptoms of COVID-19 and if they develop symptoms, contact their PCP regarding testing.
