

Admission Best Practices — Asymptomatic Residents Who Are Fully Vaccinated

This guide is to assist in determining admission best practices during the COVID-19 pandemic. Because a new admission/readmission who is fully vaccinated and have not had a known high risk exposure to COVID-19 in the last 14 days does not require quarantine or isolation unless they develop symptoms.
