Overview

This session will review the pressure ulcer quality measures that impact the Quality Measure (QM) component of the Nursing Home Compare 5-Star Quality Rating system. During the session, we will review how these measures are calculated and how they impact your overall 5-Star Quality Rating. The session will focus on best practices for reducing pressure ulcers to improve your pressure ulcer quality measures using a Quality Assurance Performance Improvement (QAPI) framework with emphasis on reduction of common MDS coding errors and implementation of a facility specific 5-Star road map action plan.

- Review how the pressure ulcer quality measures are calculated and impact the 5-Star Quality Rating score.
- Examine best practices for improving pressure ulcer quality measures impacting 5-Star Quality Rating score.
- Describe a process for establishing priority QAPI goals and actions to improve pressure ulcer quality measures.
