## What is Adult Day?

Adult day is a community-based program that provides daytime care, support, and supervision for older adults and adults with disabilities. It creates a safe, engaging environment where participants can build connections, join activities, and receive needed health and personal support—all while continuing to live at home.



- Participants: older adults, those with dementia, or individuals needing daily support
- Families and caregivers: peace of mind, respite, and extra help
- **Communities:** stronger connections and reduced healthcare strain



## What Services & Supports are Offered?

- Social and recreational activities
- Nutritious meals and snacks
- Health monitoring
- Medication assistance
- Help with daily living needs
- Transportation services (varies by program)
- Caregiver support and education

## Why it Matters

- Improves quality of life: Keeps participants active, social, and at home longer.
- Supports caregivers: Provides respite and peace of mind.
- Strengthens community: Reduces isolation and builds local connections.
- Cost-effective: More affordable than full-time residential care.
