

The CDC revised guidance which removed the requirement to screen upon entrance. To help reduce the risk of transmission of respiratory illness within our community, please follow the guidance below:

Staff

If you:

- Have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10-days, or
- Have symptoms consistent with a respiratory illness

Please do not enter the building. Call [the charge nurse] for further direction.

If you have had a high-risk exposure within the last 10 days, but are asymptomatic, please wear a mask and discuss with [the Infection Preventionist] for further direction.

Visitors

If you:

- Have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10-days, or
- Have symptoms consistent with a respiratory illness, or
- Had close contact (15 or more minutes in 24 hours within 6 feet) of someone with COVID-19

Please defer your visit until 10 days after positive test, close contact or symptom onset. If your visit is urgent, please complete hand hygiene utilize a mask and see [enter title] for further direction.

symptoms to Watch for:

Fever or Chills

Muscle or Body Aches

Congestion or Runny Nose

Cough

Headache

Nausea or Vomiting

Shortness of Breath

Sore Throat

Diarrhea

Fatigue
